This will serve as a foundation for the rest of the year. There is no written assignment over the summer, but **there will be a test over the summer reading assignment in the first two weeks of school.**

Please write your name in your Amsco book and take good care of it. I encourage you to highlight and write annotations in the book. You are also welcome to read ahead in the units if you want to get a jumpstart. Bring the book back to school with you on the first day of school! We will use them every day in the upcoming school year.
